

## **NEWSLETTER JUNE 2020**



Despite the cancellation, due to sanitary restrictions imposed by the healthcare authorities against COVID-19, of the INTEGRA *Transnational Conference on Multidisciplinary Mentorship to support the entrepreneurship of children in care and young care leavers* that was to take place in Nicosia, Cyprus, in May, the project partners agreed that it was really important to share the experiences gathered during the workshops and the pilot testing phase of the tools offered by the Mentoring Integration Program (MIP) with the minors in care.

Therefore, on June 4th, at 15 CET, the project's partners hosted the webinar #INTEGRAeu achieving the final step of the INTEGRA project with 120 registrations and 88 attendees.

The webinar was organized in different slots in order to explain how the partners have engaged the community in the project, how are the Integra online tools (MIP and Platform for Cooperation) and also how the INTEGRA Programme has been used in care practices in the partners' countries, in which representatives of the project partners HOPE FOR CHILDREN (Cyprus), CESIE (Italy), CEPS PROJECTES SOCIALS (Spain), THE SMILE OF THE CHILD (Greece) and

















**APCDP (Portugal)** presented the feedback received from the professionals that attended the workshops and that had started using the MIP toolkit with the minors.

The webinar concluded with a presentation by Christina Demetriades, Personal Coach, and Leadership and President of European Mentoring and Coaching Cyprus (EMCC) on **The importance of mentoring in the integration of vulnerable youth** and **some closing remarks** by Marina Efthimiadou, representing the Social Services of the Ministry of Labor and Social Affairs of the Republic of Cyprus.
