



Name: Skills for Wellness – Enhancement of VET offers in the wellness sector Date of Launch: April 2020, Nicosia, Cyprus

PRESS RELEASE

The "Skills for Wellness" is a KA2 Erasmus+ coordinated by Volkshochschule im Landkreis Cham e.V. (Germany) and involving six European partners (<u>Volkshochschule im Landkreis Cham e.V.</u>, <u>Satakunnan Koulutuskuntayhtymä</u>, <u>Civiform societa cooperativa sociale</u>, <u>confederacion espanola</u> <u>de centros de ensenanza asociacion C.E.C.E</u>, <u>M.M.C Management Center Limited</u>) among whom MMC from Cyprus. The project aims at designing transnational sector-wide occupational standards for professions at the wellness sector and developing and assessing competences of employees.

Occupational standards have been already created as a benchmark of competences by the six partners. The second activity of the project involves the development of training materials (practical exercises, videos, interactive tools) that are getting tested by teachers, trainers and learners as a pilot activity.

On the 29th of April the <u>3rd online transnational meeting</u> took place, during which the partners discussed the progress of the project regarding the piloting of the training resources and assessment tools; All the partners have presented an overview of the piloting progress, taking into account the following topics: effectiveness of the resources for introduction of ICT, green skills and customer communication in the context of specific needs of various customer groups.

It was decided that the next steps to be taken is the finalisation of piloting and the provision of reporting forms by mid/end of June 2021.

The partners will meet again in September 2021 to discuss the development of the project and the next steps.
