WeCan is a 3-year Erasmus+ funded project with the aim of "Encouraging Integration for Newly Arrived Immigrant Women through Entrepreneurship" and has a partnership from 6 European countries (SE, UK, UA, NL, EL, and CY) under the leadership of Folkuniversitetet.

As the Covid-19 situation got better, the partnership had the opportunity to have the **4th transnational meeting**, in-person, on **20th October 2021** in Tilburg, the Netherlands. The partners had the opportunity to discuss the development of the piloting workshops that took place in each country and shared experiences and lessons learnt.

Subsequently, the main focus of the discussion was the development and implementation of IO3: Guidance for professionals working with low-skilled women with entrepreneurial ideas. The objective of IO3 is the efficient consulting, coaching and supporting of migrant women in the context of their integration into the labor market through entrepreneurship. The guide will analyze the ways how immigrant/refugee women entrepreneur can assess and develop a business idea.
