In the course of our project Eufast, the training of the migrants and refugees role models, as part of the deliverables of our project, has taken place between the 1st and 3rd of November 2021.

During the training, selected role models (2 from each partner country) had been explained the use of the brand new Eufast application and they were thoroughly informed about its purpose and goal. The new application consists of different social scenarios, which are used to promote social integration skills for newly arrived migrants and refugees. They were also trained in mentoring and empowering methodologies, to be used when they are in contact with the beneficiaries of the project; newly arrived refugees or migrants.

EUFAST is an Erasmus+ project, funded under call for proposals KA2 - "Cooperation for Innovation and the Exchange of Good Practices", in the field of "Strategic Partnerships for Adult Education" (KA204), which has officially started on the 1st of November 2019 and it will be concluded on the 31st of October 2021.
