## **PRESS RELEASE**

On the 12<sup>th</sup> of November 2021 Mediterranean Management Centre Ltd hosted a transnational meeting of the project Eufast, in Nicosia, Cyprus. The meeting was hybrid with some of the partners participating online to the meeting.

As the project is towards its end, the meeting was a great opportunity for the partnership to do a review of the work finalized during the previous months and discuss the final steps.



EUFAST is an Erasmus+ project, funded under call for proposals KA2 - "Cooperation for Innovation and the Exchange of Good Practices", in the field of "Strategic Partnerships for Adult Education" (KA204), which has officially started on the 1st of November 2019.

The project is coordinated by CoCreate, Greece and the project partners are the following: M.M.C. Mediterranean Management Centre from Cyprus, Omega Tech and Integration Center for Migrant Workers - Ecumenical Refugee Program (ECRP) from Greece, Centre Recursos d'Iniciatives i Autocupació sI (CRIA) and Ajuntament de Sant Boi de Llobregat from Spain, Associazione Salam Ong from Italy, and Akademie Klausenhof hof gGmbH from Germany.







The meeting started with a welcome note by the coordinator of the project, **COCREATE**, and a description of the agenda and the topics to be discussed during the meeting. The coordinator, gave a summary of the deliverables that have been concluded, namely the pedagogical and gamification framework as well as the training of the role models of the project. During the training that took place recently, selected role models (2 from each partner country) had been explained the use of the brand new Eufast application and they were thoroughly informed about its purpose and goal.

Subsequently, the partner Omega Tech presented to the partnership the progress of the Eufast application and the last steps to be taken for the finalization of the application. It is now the time for the partnership to start the pilot implementation in order to train immigrants to use the application.

In addition, the dissemination activities were also discussed during the meeting, as well as the plan to disseminate future developments and deliverables.
