MMC Management Center Ltd hosted in Nicosia, Cyprus, the kick-off meeting of our new project **COViR**, on the 18<sup>th</sup> of October 2021. COViR is an Erasmus+ project, funded under the call for proposals KA2 - Cooperation for innovation and the exchange of good practices in the field of "Partnerships for Digital Education Readiness". The project is coordinated by Lukasiewicz-National Agency (Poland) and the partners







are: MMC Management Center Ltd (Cyprus), EDITC (Cyprus), Kypriaki Etaireia Pistopiisis (Cyprus), Fundacion Equipo Humano (Spain) and Senseworks (Greece).

CoViR aims to develop through co-creation participatory processes a pioneer multiuser e-learning platform embedding virtual reality collaboration rooms that will simulate class training while offering innovative tools (inside the 3D environment) that will allow for different kind of interaction between the trainer and the trainees. The results, a VR collaborative training platform with supporting e-learning materials and a comprehensive guide are expected to create impact in the VET sector promoting the use of modern technologies in online training.

At the beginning of the meeting the coordinator gave a welcoming note, introducing the organization and also established the state of art for the project. Subsequently, MMC Management Center, presented, as a host, the main activities of the organization. The coordinator, made an overview of the project and the different steps to be taken in the future by the partners.

Senseworks, offered the partnership the opportunity to have a hands-on experience of the Oculus Quest 2 Standalone headsets with sensors during the meeting (learning space and other exemplary apps) which will be the tool to be used for the COViR learning platform. The meeting continued with a presentation by the responsible partner of each deliverable of the project. Each partner presented their expertise related to the tasks allocated to them in the project and made an overview of future steps to be taken.

Before the end of the meeting, the partnership decided on a common dissemination and exploitation strategy to be followed and scheduled the next meeting of the partnership which will take place online.
