LEARN: 1st (Kick Off) Project Meeting (Online), 5-6 March 2020

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the consortium was obliged to implement the kick off meeting of the project as online meeting through Zoom, on the 5th and 6th of March 2020.

During the meeting, the partners met each other for the first time and introduced their organisations to the consortium. The coordinator presented the philosophy, aims and objectives of the project as well as the work packages and relevant activities.

Emphasis was placed on WP3: “Implementation of Research to Identify the Views of Employers and Employees as far as Learning in the Workplace is Concerned”. The research in this work package will be implemented through focus groups with Employers/Employer Representatives and Employees.
