The Final Conference, titled "Strategic Transformation of Organisations into Learning Workplaces: the LEARN Project," took place on 14th June 2023 in Nicosia, Cyprus. This milestone event was co-organized under the prestigious Erasmus+ co-funded project, "Towards a holistic transformation of organisations into learning workplaces," in collaboration with the Cyprus Chamber of Commerce and Industry, MMC Mediterranean Management Centre, and the Cyprus Certification Company.

Gathering around 100 enthusiastic participants, the conference provided an exceptional platform to showcase the remarkable achievements of the LEARN project. Distinguished speakers representing Chambers of Commerce, Vocational Education and Training (VET) providers, a renowned certification company, and esteemed universities, took the stage to present the project's groundbreaking accomplishments.

The LEARN project stands as a testament to its commitment to revolutionizing workplace learning and skill development. Among its most significant achievements, the project has developed an innovative certification scheme, empowering organizations to embark on a transformative journey towards becoming dynamic Learning Workplaces. In addition to the certification scheme, the project also unveiled comprehensive training materials designed to foster positive attitudes among employers and employees, encouraging a culture of continuous learning and growth. Furthermore, employees were equipped with specialized training material focused on mastering six key transversal skills, highly sought-after by employers in today's competitive job market.

The project's impact is further magnified by the creation of 43 learning activities and tools, meticulously designed to facilitate the transformation of organizations into thriving learning-driven entities. To gauge the effectiveness of this initiative, the LEARN project introduced two attitude tests, providing valuable insights for further refinement.

A notable highlight of the LEARN project is the development of an ISO-certified assessment tool, a pioneering system that evaluates and certifies employees' proficiency in the six key transversal skills, setting a new industry benchmark for skill recognition. Throughout the project's journey, it has successfully conducted targeted training sessions, reaching 125 employer representatives and 107 employees, all of whom played a pivotal role in driving the project's success. Impressively, 36 employees were assessed and certified with ISO17024, affirming their mastery of the six key transversal skills.

The Final Conference marked an inspiring culmination of the LEARN project, leaving an indelible impact on the future of workplace learning and development.
