2nd Transnational face-to-face Project Meeting for the GreenComp School project: Cross sectoral Green Comp training of primary school stakeholders, for the promotion of a Sustainability Mindset

Perugia, Italy

The 2nd transnational face to face meeting for the Green Comp project: “Cross sectoral Green Comp training of primary school stakeholders, for the promotion of a Sustainability Mindset” took place in Perugia, Italy between 21-22 of September 2023.

The Green Comp School project, initiated during 2022, as a response to the need for developing competences related to sustainability. In essence, it seeks to develop blended training for all educational sectors with the goal to foster sustainability mindsets of primary school students and their parents. This change of stance is aspired to take place by training and equipping teachers and students of HE primary school departments with micro credential courses and flexible interdisciplinary training for primary school students and their parents.



In the two days of the face-to-face meeting in Perugia, representatives from all the partners of the consortium participated namely: Univeristy of Thessaly, Perifereiaki Diefthinsi Protovathmias & Defterovathmias Ekpaidefsis Thessalias, Mediterranean Management Center Ltd (MMC), Frederick University, Tiber Umbria Comett Education Programme (TUCEP), DIMITRA EKPAIDEYTIKI SIMVOULEFTIKI, Direzione Didattica Secondo Circolo PG, Universita Degli Studi Di Perugia, FU-UPPSALA.

At the first day, the current status of the project was discussed in terms of work done and remaining steps. The presentation of the international report took place and feedback was provided for further improvement of the contents. The first day closed with the analysis of the training needs per competence area of the Green Comp revised framework tailored for the primary school. At the second day, the presentation of the “Development of Micro Credential Training Courses” took place in terms of its scope, micro credentials approach, work programme and work allocation. The day was concluded with setting the next steps for the implementation of the specific work package. Finally, the 3rd Transnational project meeting (adjacent training) was decided to take place between 19-21/6/2024 in Nicosia.
