Green Comp School: Completion of the final international report

25th September 2023

The Green Comp consortium is in the position to announce that the final version of the international report has been completed. The report is the result of focus group interviews conducted by the partners in all project partner countries, namely: Greece (DIMITRA Education & Consulting, University of Thessaly-UTH, The Regional Directorate for Primary and Secondary Education of Thessaly-P.D.E.Th), Italy (TUCEP-Tiber Umbria Comett Education Programme, Direzione Didattica Secondo Circolo Perugia, Università degli Studi di Perugia), Cyprus (FREDERICK University & M.M.C MANAGEMENT CENTER LIMITED) and Sweden (Folkuniversitetet). It is based on the exchange of information on the applicability of the GreenComp framework in primary education and the search for a synthesis of the views expressed and a convenient balance between the processes, tools and responsibilities of teachers and education providers involved in the teaching of GreenComp competences.

As an overall remark, it can be argued that the findings of the focus group discussion contribute sufficiently to validate the GreenComp framework for the primary education context and to identify targeted competencies for primary teachers and students. The need for a holistic and integrated approach to sustainability education, which includes practical activities, policy integration and continuous awareness raising is highlighted.

The report corresponds to the achievement and completion of the project's objectives. Therefore, it sets the basis to build its future outputs. However, apart its main outcome of providing the revised GreenComp framework; the partnership will use it also to develop the Learning outcomes for the Training materials of the direct beneficiaries.
