BlueDivet Learning and Training Activity at Piraeus, Greece



Mentors representing eight collaborating organizations from Spain, Greece, Cyprus, and Bulgaria participated in the learning and training activities of the BlueDivet project, held from October 30, 2023, to November 3, 2023. The event was organized by the Greek partner IDEC and took place in Piraeus, Greece.

Building upon the established “Curriculum for Vocational Training in the field of blue digitalization profile,” which constitutes Project Result 2, mentors actively participated in the refinement of pedagogical content and materials for vocational training focused on blue digitalization within the realm of blue growth.

The finalized training package will undergo a pilot phase, wherein the course will be presented to a cohort of 80 participants from the partner countries. This phase aims to assess the final output, allowing for evaluation and refinement as needed.





The training's **host organization IDEC** (<https://idec.gr/>) is a company specialized in business consulting, training services and high-tech applications. It has been active in the Greek and international markets since 1989.

IDEC deserves appreciation for affording participants in the BlueDivet project training the opportunity to witness the Piraeus port, one of the largest in the Mediterranean. 

It was a great opportunity for Andalucía Emprende to present the European project #BLUEDIVET to relevant actors related to the blue economy.



BlueDivet Synergizes with Other Projects Related to the Blue Economy

The **WINBLUE project**, supported by EMFAF and titled “Empowering Women and Mainstreaming Gender Equality in the Blue Economy” (<https://winblue-project.eu/>), was introduced to participants from Spain, Greece, Cyprus, and Bulgaria during the training course in Piraeus, Greece, on 03/11/2023, following the official training program for the day.

As a partner in the WINBLUE project, VEDA representatives have the

chance to engage with the IDEC team in discussions addressing challenges and barriers faced by women in the blue economy sectors, which are in the focus of this project.



Currently the IDEC implements over 60 EU funded projects, among them the project **Blue-C** – “Collaborating Coastal Communities through Co-Work Co-Design & Co-Creation” (<https://inishowen.ie/blue-c/>) and the **SECOVE** - “Sustainable Energy Centres of Vocational Excellence” (<https://secove-project.eu/>). The second project aims to establish a cooperation platform for Centers of Vocational Excellence (CoVEs) across Europe in the sector of renewable and sustainable energy with focus also on attracting more women in that sector.



Innovation Fund 2023 Call Info Day

On 7 December, 2023 the European Climate, Infrastructure and Environment Executive Agency (CINEA) and the European Commission's DG Climate Action are organising an **Informational Day to present the Innovation Fund 2023 Call (IF23 Call)**.

The IF23 Call was launched on 23 November with a budget of €4 billion, from revenues from the EU Emissions Trading System. This new **call will be open to small, medium, and large-scale projects and will cover sectors including decarbonisation, cleantech manufacturing, maritime and energy-intensive industries**. The application window will be open until early April 2024.

The info day will guide the participants through all the novelties of this call, and present lessons learned from previous calls. Additionally, during the event, participants will have the opportunity to ask questions via Slido using #IF23Call. The presentations and recording will be made available afterwards.
