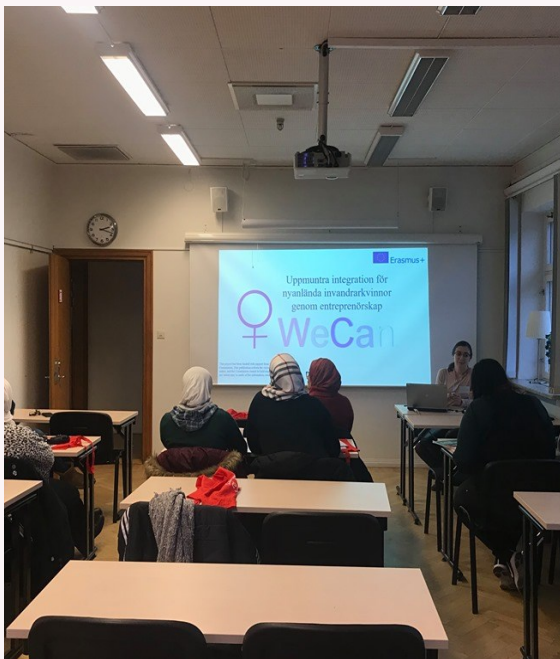




# WeCan Project launched

## *Empowerment*

The strategy of connecting with women NGO will enable active participation of the primary target group. The project will also to reach immigrant women from local female or migrant/refugee organisations, as well as vocational education and training institutions that can complement their academic curriculum with the specific knowledge, skills, and attitudes offered by the WeCan learning curriculum.

Josef Ahman noted that, it is crucial to support the target group (immigrant/refugee women) by empowering and helping them at early stages of integration in the host country.

## Sustainability of the project results

The partners of the project will also connect with the most relevant European organisations to secure their cooperation in the transfer of the project results. Such platforms will increase the resonance of the project and will facilitate other parties to access the information and documents beyond the project lifetime.
